

GRISART

1. OBJECTIVE OF THE CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The aim of the call for applications is to provide people with photographic talent with access to the studies that form part of Grisart's Training Programme.

2. PARTICIPANTS

- 2.1. The scholarships are aimed at participants of any nationality, over 18 years of age.
- 2.2. Participants must be fluent in Spanish.

3. AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS

The Grisart Scholarships 2022 call for applications offers two types of scholarships with the following amounts in courses:

- Grisart Scholarship for the Technical Itinerary: Endowed with the 1st year of the Professional Studies Plan valued at €6,000. **(Only in Spanish)**

Grisart Grant for Photographic Narrative: Endowed with the Project Creation course with Enric Montes and the Photobook Self-Publishing course with Román Yñán valued at €3,785. **(Only in Spanish)**

- 3.1. The beneficiary will take the course offered by Grisart free of charge during the next academic year 2022-2023.

4. DOCUMENTATION

Each participant must submit the following documentation:

A: Application form, duly completed, which can be found at <https://www.grisart.com/estudios/#becas>.

B: Digital copy of identity card or passport.

C: Full curriculum vitae (maximum 2,500 characters without spaces).

D: Motivation letter explaining what motivates the participant to study photography (maximum 2,500 characters without spaces).

E: Presentation of portfolio:

25-40 photographs of the same project or of two different projects. Each project submitted must be accompanied by an argumentative report (statement and description of the project).

All photographs must meet the following requirements: The size shall be 1,600 pixels on their longest side. The file format must be JPEG quality (10). The images must be numbered consecutively and in order of edition (01. 02. 03. Etc)

5. PROCESSING AND DELIVERY DEADLINES

All the documentation will be sent in a single compressed file using the web application: wetransfer.com.

This file must contain two folders:

The "Form" folder, which will contain the documentation of sections A, B, C and D.

The folder "Photographs", which will store all the images.

This digital file must be compressed using a .zip file. You can use one of these applications to compress your files:

- 7-Zip
- WinRAR
- WinZip

To send your files correctly, you can follow these steps:

Step 1: Generate the compressed .zip file with the contents explained above and with the following nomenclature: `first_name.zip`

Step 2: Go to the page wetransfer.com

Step 3: Add the .zip file in the first field of the form.

Step 4: Type "beca@grisart.com" in the destination email address field.

Step 5: Enter your email address in the sender's email field, so that you will receive confirmation of delivery of the file in your mailbox.

Step 6: In the last field you can leave comments (optional).

Step 7: Click on the "Transfer" button to start the sending process.

The e-mail address indicated in step 5 will be notified of the status of the file transfer process.

Under no circumstances will copies on paper, CD, DVD or other media be accepted.

5.1. The deadline for submission of applications is Wednesday 25 May at 23:59h (Barcelona UTC/GMT +1 hour).

5.2. Applications submitted after the deadline or which do not meet the requirements described in the rules will not be accepted.

6. RESOLUTION

Once all the applications have been evaluated, Grisart will contact and interview (in person or online) the 8 finalists of this call.

The resolution of the call will be announced on Friday 10 June at 18:00h (Barcelona UTC/GMT +1 hour).

6.1. The resolution will be made public on the Grisart website www.grisart.com. Likewise, all participants will receive an e-mail notification with the jury's decision.

6.2. In order to guarantee transparency in the selection process, Grisart will appoint a jury made up of prominent people in the field of professional photography and teachers from the school.

6.3. The jury's decision will be final.

6.4. Grants may not be left vacant.

6.5. Files not selected will be eliminated.

7. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- 7.1. Participation in this call for applications implies acceptance of these conditions.
- 7.2. The person awarded the grant will take the course in the timetable established by Grisart.
- 7.3. Under no circumstances will the grant be replaced by its economic value. The concession of the grant is limited exclusively to the course, and not to the fungible materials derived from the development of the course, and which, by default, are not assumed by the school.
- 7.4. Grisart and the scholarship holder will sign an agreement in which the conditions of the scholarship will be specified in writing.
- 7.5. In the event that the scholarship holder demonstrates poor performance and/or exceeds the number of absences allowed, Grisart may decide to immediately withdraw the scholarship and, consequently, the scholarship holder will be removed from the course.
- 7.6. The scholarship course must inevitably take place during the academic period. A postponement to later academic years will not be accepted.
- 7.7. The names of the winners and their photographs may appear in the school's publicity and in the dissemination of future scholarships.
- 7.8. Failure to comply with any of the requirements or the lack of the required documentation will mean exclusion from this call for applications.
- 7.9. Any situation not foreseen in these rules will be resolved by Grisart.
